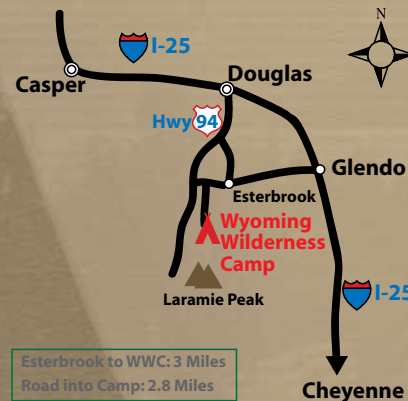

Wyoming Wilderness Camp (formerly known as H-R Camp) provides an opportunity to enjoy Christian living in a natural environment. "We Can with God's Help" is the camp theme for summer 2010. Located in Esterbrook, Wyoming, the camp is 28 miles from Douglas in the Laramie Mountains of the Medicine Bow National Forest (see map on back). Through Christian worship, mountain hiking, arts and crafts, music and campfires, youth build a stronger faith and create relationships that last a lifetime.

Wyoming Wilderness Camp (WWC) is a facility and ministry of the Episcopal Church in Wyoming. The program and operations are governed by the Wyoming Wilderness Camp Foundation Board. The mission of the camp is to provide an opportunity for young people to live in a Christ-centered community that experiences outdoor activities in a safe, structured and environmentally-sensitive manner.

Select Camp Descriptions

Camp #1 - Caregivers Camp

A new weekend retreat experience for those adults who work and care for others. It is an opportunity for rest, relaxation, recharging in the setting of God's Outdoor Kingdom.

Camp #6 - Music, Art, and Photography Camp

The third combined music, art, and photography camp will again be offered to youth ages 6th grade through high school. This camp uses the outdoor setting of WWC for self discovery, and open air discovery to God's outdoor kingdom.

Camp #8 - Angel Camp

This is a new offering for WWC in an effort to serve children and youth of those families who live among us and are without a home. In a cooperative effort with the Natrona county School District, the camp is offering a week long camp experience for these children.

Camp #10 - Wind River Mission Camp

A tremendous opportunity for youth adults to discover and develop leadership skills, and to practically apply those skills doing mission work on the Wind River Reservation.

Scholarship/Policy Information

It is the policy of Wyoming Wilderness Camp that no young person should be excluded from participation for financial reasons. Therefore, limited scholarships are available. Please contact the H-R Camp Foundation at (307)-265-5200, or pat@wyomingdiocese.org for details. Wyoming Wilderness Camp procedures for reservations are as follows:

- Registrations received on or before May 22, 2010, will be confirmed by June 22, 2010.
- Registrations received after May 22, 2010, will be confirmed no later than 2 weeks before the first day of the camp session.
- Confirmation letters will include a description of payments received, camp dates, check-in and pick-up times, and a list of things to bring.

WWC ACTIVITIES PERMISSION AND MEDICAL AUTHORIZATION FORM FOR THE H-R CAMP FOUNDATION

I, the parent or legal guardian of my son/daughter named below, hereby give my permission for said child to participate in the activity below which is sponsored by the H-R Camp Foundation. I understand that this activity will be held at Wyoming Wilderness Camp.

I understand that I will be notified as soon as possible in the event of an emergency, but in the event I cannot be contacted immediately, I also hereby authorize and consent to emergency First Aid, to medical examination, and to x-ray, anesthetic, medical, dental, or surgical diagnosis, treatment, and care rendered by or under the general or special supervision of licensed medical personnel.

This authorization is given in advance of any specific diagnosis, treatment, or hospital care required, and is given to provide authority and power to render such diagnosis, treatment, and care which is deemed advisable in the best judgment of a medical doctor. It is understood that no diagnosis, treatment, or care will be withheld if the undersigned cannot be reached.

In the event of illness or injury, I waive any and all claims now existing, known or unknown, or arising hereafter, and specifically agree that the Episcopal Diocese of Wyoming, H-R Camp Foundation and any related corporation or entity, their agents and employees and any activities leaders (collectively "the Church and its Agents") connected with this activity are fully released from any and all liability and damages except for those arising from the negligent acts or omissions of the Church or its Agents.
